Every course is staffed by school board members.

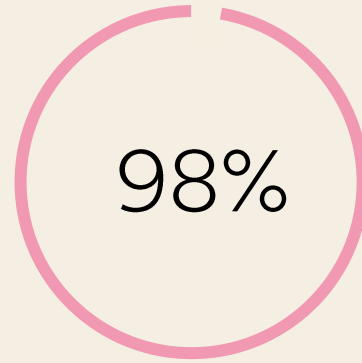


Once enrolled with EF, the School Board will take care of the enrolment of your child in summer school.

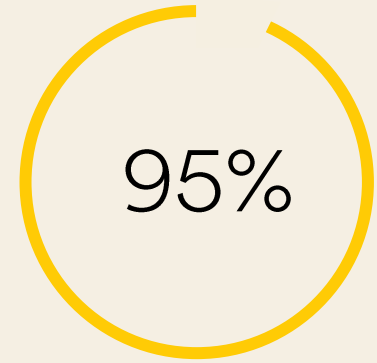
