

# 2020 Summer C-AMP Descriptions

## Instrumental Music C-AMP

Monday, July 6, 2020 – Friday, July 10, 2020 from 8:30AM – 1:30PM

**Learn to play the ukulele!** Students are invited to experience this enjoyable and rewarding week-long music camp that focuses on musical literacy. All experience backgrounds and abilities are welcome as we collaborate in the art of music making. Students will learn fundamental techniques to support literacy and performance skills on the ukulele while learning fun and recognizable songs.

Required Materials: We will provide students with a ukulele for the duration of the Instrumental Music C-AMP. Curbside pick-up of the ukulele's will be available

## Visual Arts Summer C-AMPs

### Exploring the Elements of Art

Monday, July 6, 2020 – Friday, July 10, 2020 from 8:30AM – 1:30PM

Students will review and strengthen literacy skills by learning about the elements of art—line, colour, shape, form, texture and value through various art explorations. In learning about the building blocks of art, students will also apply their literacy skills by creating a variety of pieces involving drawing techniques and some mixed media.

Required Materials: We will provide students with a sketchbook, sketching pencils, eraser, coloured pencils, a pad of construction paper, scissors and glue stick. Curbside pick-up of materials will be available **Thursday, July 2, 2020 from 8AM – 10AM at All Saints Catholic Secondary School (3001 Country Ln, Whitby).**

### Improving Drawing and Colouring Skills

Monday, July 13, 2020 – Friday, July 17, 2020 from 8:30AM – 1:30PM

Students will strengthen literacy skills by learning about specific drawing and shading techniques as well as exploring pencil crayon application. Students will learn some techniques and skills through a variety of guided drawing and colouring lessons, and then work on differentiated products during their own studio time.

Required Materials: We will provide students with a sketchbook, sketching pencils, coloured pencils, and a ruler. Curbside pick-up of materials will be available **Thursday, July 9, 2020 from 8AM – 10AM at All Saints Catholic Secondary School (3001 Country Ln, Whitby).**

## Watercolour and Photography

Monday, July 20, 2020 – Friday, July 24, 2020 from 8:30AM – 1:30PM

Students will enhance literacy and comprehension skills while participating in some guided painting lessons using watercolour. Students will also explore some introductory photography skills and techniques, expand their literacy regarding terminology and key concepts, and develop a good eye for composition.

Required Materials: Students will also need to have access to their own camera on a device (smart phone or tablet, or DSLR Camera).

We will provide students with a sketchbook, watercolour paints, canvas, and brushes. Curbside pick-up of materials will be available **Thursday, July 16, 2020 from 8AM – 10AM at All Saints Catholic Secondary School (3001 Country Ln, Whitby).**

## Musical Theatre C-AMP
