Item Loan Policies

1. The parent/guardian, together with the student, assumes responsibility for the musical instrument for the duration it's in their possession, and to reimburse All Saints Catholic Secondary School for any loss of or damage to the instrument (valued at \$40 CAD).
2. The instrument and case (where applicable) will be returned to the school on Monday, July 10, 2020, or on the request of the teacher, whichever occurs first. You are expected to return the instrument to the music teacher for inspection, cleaned and in good working condition.
3. The student and parent/guardian are responsible for any damage beyond normal wear and tear. If the instrument is lost or damaged beyond repair during the rental period, you agree to pay the full amount of the loss value of \$40 CAD. It is extremely important that you report damages to us as soon as possible after they happen because damages will often worsen over time and increase the cost to repair.
4. If the ukulele is not returned on Monday, July 10, 2020 between 8AM – 10AM at All Saints Catholic Secondary School, a late fee of \$10 CAD per day may be charged, unless other arrangements have been made with the teacher.
